Mission

This website is intended to promote further biblical reform and to enlighten and inform those who are in Christ that they may acquire a sound biblical knowledge of God and His involvement with the affairs of mankind. Five basic doctrinal principles, as attested to by Scripture, form the foundation upon which this effort rests. The first of those is that Truth is revealed to us from and through God alone. Secondly, that all doctrinal authority must be based upon God's Word alone. Thirdly, that salvation is received exclusively by God's grace alone. Fourthly, that our response and appropriation of that grace is through a God-given faith alone. Fifth, that the object of that faith is Jesus Christ alone. A detailed statement of our beliefs, which underlies this entire work, is available in our Doctrinal Statement. Although this website is not specifically designed to be an evangelical outreach, the Gospel can be found embedded within the text of many pages of its books and newsletters. Additionally, we have provided a clear presentation of the Gospel as a separate document, which is readily accessible from our Home Page.

Documents on this website are provided in the Portable Document Format (PDF).
